Welcome back from our brief shut down! Hopefully you have been back to the Club since we reopened, and you find the upgrades and improvements favorable. Our Dockmaster Brent, who is a "Jack of all trades" even did the plumbing and cable hook ups himself! This has been a real team effort that all of our members in the basin

now and in the future will benefit from!

While we are speaking of the Basin, I want to let you all know that we have several wet slips available. They range in several sizes to upwards of 36', with varying widths and depths. If you are interested, please contact Brent, or see Ken or Alice! And remember, all of our slips have brand new power pedestals! WOOHOO!

Many of you have probably noticed that the Diving Board has been broken for a month and have shared your frustration about this. We are working on a solution, but it looks like we will have to dig up the old stands and anchor in new ones. I know some of you get upset with us when we "crack down" on diving board use that is not consistent with our rules. Unfortunately, some of these indiscretions have led to the diving board's current condition. Please, when the new Board is installed, use it responsibly, and make sure your children understand this is an amenity for all to use and not abuse.

In an effort to protect our members, we have recently purchased an AED (Automated External Defibrillator). Our BYC Crew will be getting trained in its use, and getting certified in CPR in the near future. The AED will be located down by the offices. Hopefully, we will never have to use it...but if we do, we will be ready!

## Treasurer's Report

FINANCIAL REPORT 2012-13

### Net Operating Revenue

BYC exceeded financial expectations last year. Most things broke the right way. Our net revenue from Operations was \$44,462 vs. a budgeted income of \$3,406. This is up slightly from a net of \$35,487 in the prior year. This is a nice but slim net income of 1.7% on Revenues of \$2,694,445. Noticeably, fuel sales were 30% (\$194,000) under budget, but they contribute little profit to operations as markup to members is slight and 91% of our fuel sales are to members. Among the winners, Food & Beverage Income, including banquets, exceeded revenue budget by \$43,098 and gross margin budget by \$37,012, despite a slight drop in member's participation. Kudos to

management and staff. We estimate that 78% of active members spend about \$115 per month on food and beverage in the average month. The range is 67% @ \$100-Summer to 82% @ \$145-Spring. A little more members' spending would be helpful. Across our "fixed" expenses, contained pluses and minuses but we finished under the budgeted expenses by \$7,000, despite negative surprises in unemployment insurance, new member, computer and maintenance expenses. In addition we had Misc. Income and Expenses, which include 90% of Initiation, RCIF, Interest, Donations and depreciation expense. This amounted to a positive income boost of \$102,902, which goes into capital reserves.

### Balance Sheet

We ended the year with \$1,565,741 in cash vs. \$1,415,905 at the end of last year. Members' equity (net worth) increased by \$147,364 to \$2,554,660. In our capital accounts we have: \$497,170 RCIF plus \$278, 558 capital funds for a total of \$775,728 restricted and \$128,210 unrestricted. This provided a Grand Total of capital funds available of \$903,938.

### Accounts Receivable

There has been a large improvement in past due Accounts Receivable. Significantly we had no write-offs for bad debt.

Detailed Financial Reports are always posted on the bulletin board across from Alice McCann's office. •

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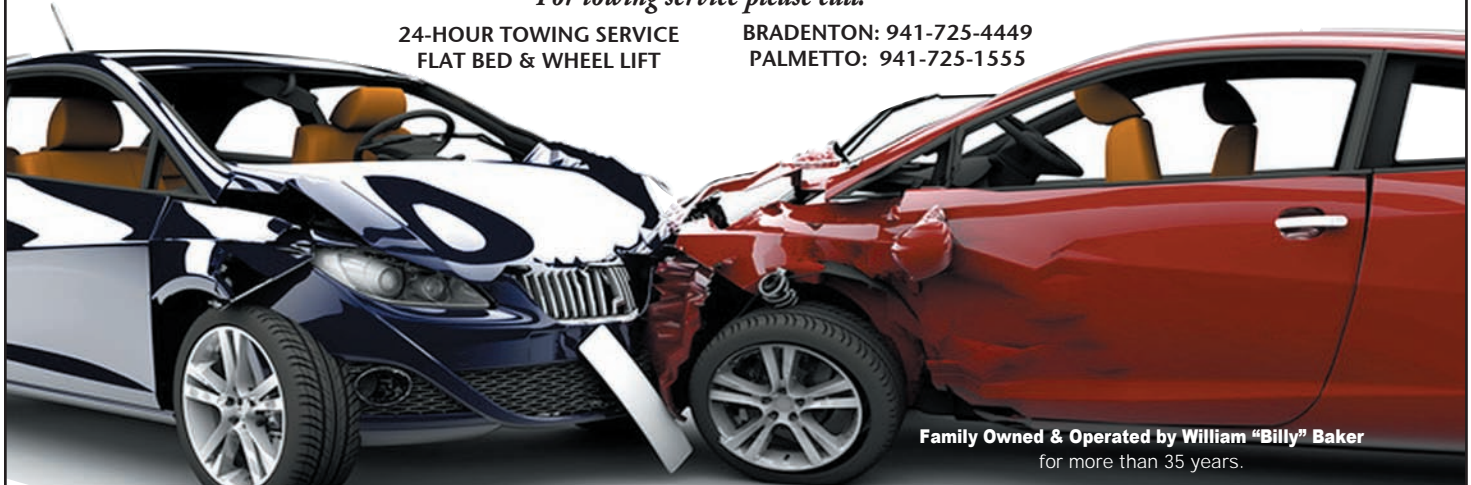
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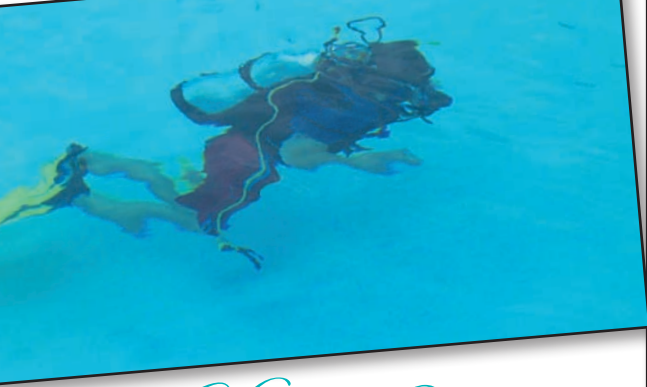

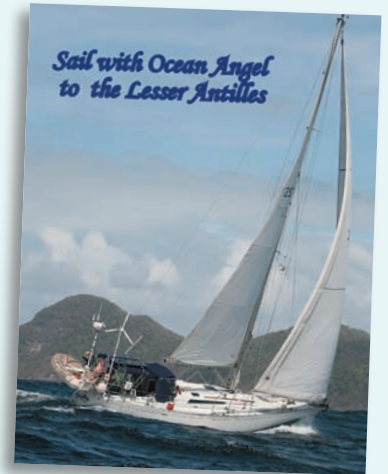

What this means for you is...when you access the site from your mobile device such as an iPhone, iPad, Android or Blackberry, you will see a login screen that takes you to your statement area and the club roster.

Need to know how to contact a member on the go and you don't have their number? Login and look at their contact record that should have their phone number and other information they have provided. Speaking of contact records, it's up to you, the Member, to enter the information in your record that you would like other Members to see. In addition to the Member's Name, Address, Phone and date joined, there are additional fields for information if you would like to share more. This is where you would enter an additional phone number, your significant other's name, cell phone, email address along with your boat name, make and length. 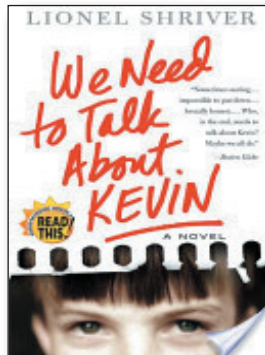

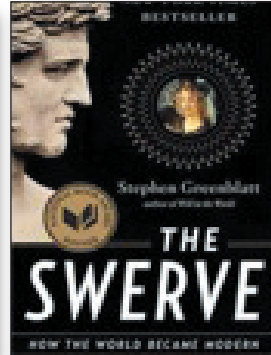

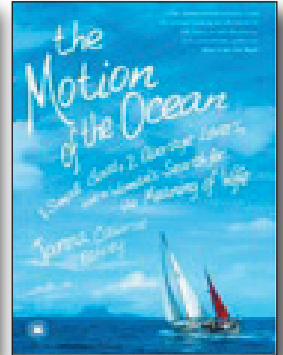
